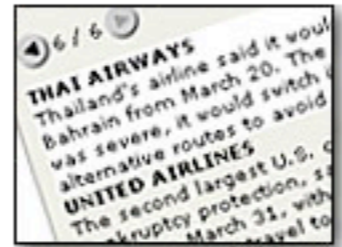

THE TARGET OF Monday's action is American President Lines, a cargo carrier that has contracts with the Defense Department to ship supplies to U.S. forces overseas.

The port of Oakland is the fourth-busiest cargo container port in the United States.

'UNJUST AND ILLEGAL'

"Whether or not war cargo is there on that day, we are trying to send a message to APL that we oppose their profiting off this unjust and illegal war," said Sasha Wright, an organizer with Direct Action to Stop the War. "We will hold them accountable."
